Access to Trail/ Parking	The starting point of this urban route is the Gravenhurst Centennial Centre, 101 Centennial Dr. just off of Church St. Walk from the Centennial Centre along Muskoka Road, under the Gateway Arch to Kinsmen Park and back along First St.
Distance (km)	4.8 km
Total # of steps	6345
Difficulty (easy, moderate, difficult)	easy
Trail Description/ Key Points of Interest	Gravenhurst is considered the “Gateway to Muskoka” - the first town people encounter as they enter Muskoka from the south. This urban route will keep your heart healthy as you take a walk through the heart of Gravenhurst. Browse the unique shops along Muskoka Rd., visit the century old Gravenhurst Opera House, the Bethune Memorial Statue, and the historical Gateway Arch as you continue the walk to Kinsmen Park. The park has many features, including the Centennial Bear Fountain, a pond, picnic shelters, several gardens and a playground for young children and families.
