Access to Trail/ Parking	The trail is located on the Muskoka Wharf property. The boardwalk/trail can be accessed from parking lots at Cherokee Lane, Muskoka Rd. 169, James St. and Steamship Bay Rd. The Peninsula Trail portion can be accessed via trailheads at the marina and from the boardwalk between the museum and the hotel.

Trail Description/ Key Points of Interest	Along the shore of Lake Muskoka this stroller friendly trail travels the boardwalk and goes between the sports fields. The Peninsula Trail portion is on natural surfaces including rocky terrain and stairs. Easy walking with breathtaking views, several gazebos, benches and tables. Refresh yourselves at the Splash Pad. Pass by the wheelhouses of the Islander and RMS Cherokee steamships. Docked at the Wharf are the Wenonah II, the Wanda III and also the R.M.S. Segwun. The Segwun is the oldest operating steamship in North America.
