

Oxtongue Rapids Hiking Trail

Closest Community	Dwight
Access to Trail/ Parking	From the intersection of Hwy 35 and Hwy 60 in Dwight follow Hwy 60 east 2 km to Oxtongue Rapids Park Rd. Turn right and follow this paved road 1 km. At this point the road becomes a narrow gravel road. Proceed 2 km to the monument in Oxtongue Rapids Park.
Distance (km)	3.7 km
Total # of steps	3909
Difficulty (easy, moderate, difficult)	difficult
Trail Description/ Key Points of Interest	Caution, this trail follows the shore of fast moving water with rocky slopes to the river's edge. Parents must keep small children close at all times! This is one of the beauty spots of Muskoka. From the monument travel west along the trail to the left of the road you arrived on. At times the trail will follow the road itself as it comes quite close to the river. This rugged terrain highlights natural grown forest, a steep incline and descent. It is a good nature walk featuring untouched perimeters, wildlife and birds. Return the same way or follow the road back to the monument. Picnic facilities are available.
