Access to Trail/ Parking	Take District Road 4 north of Bracebridge onto Hwy 141 west and then to Fish Hatchery Rd. Parking is available at Fish Hatchery Park, 1.3 km past Watt Public School.

Difficulty (easy, moderate, difficult)	easy
Trail Description/ Key Points of Interest	This former fish hatchery produced trout annually by raising fingerlings and releasing them in local lakes and streams. It was closed in the early 1990's, as production was concentrated in the newer hatcheries throughout the province. The trail winds past the stream and ponds where restoration work had taken place to naturalize the former hatchery. Ten interpretive signs offer information and illustrations on different habitats, flora and fauna of the area, complimented by advice on conservation techniques that individuals can use to preserve the natural heritage of Muskoka.
